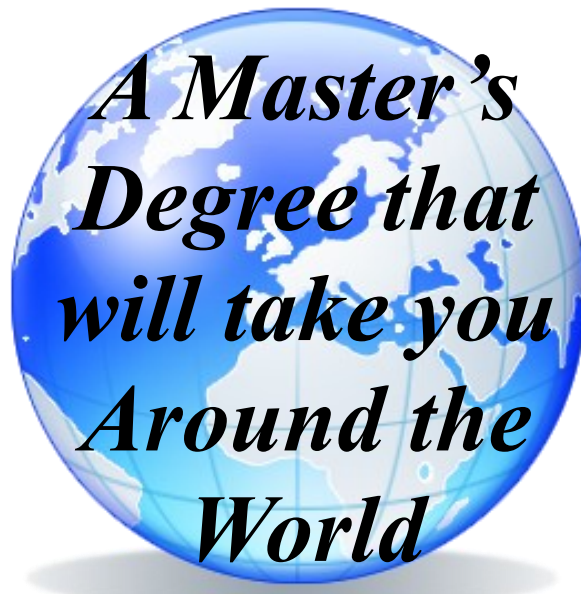

TROY's MSIR is a 12-course program
